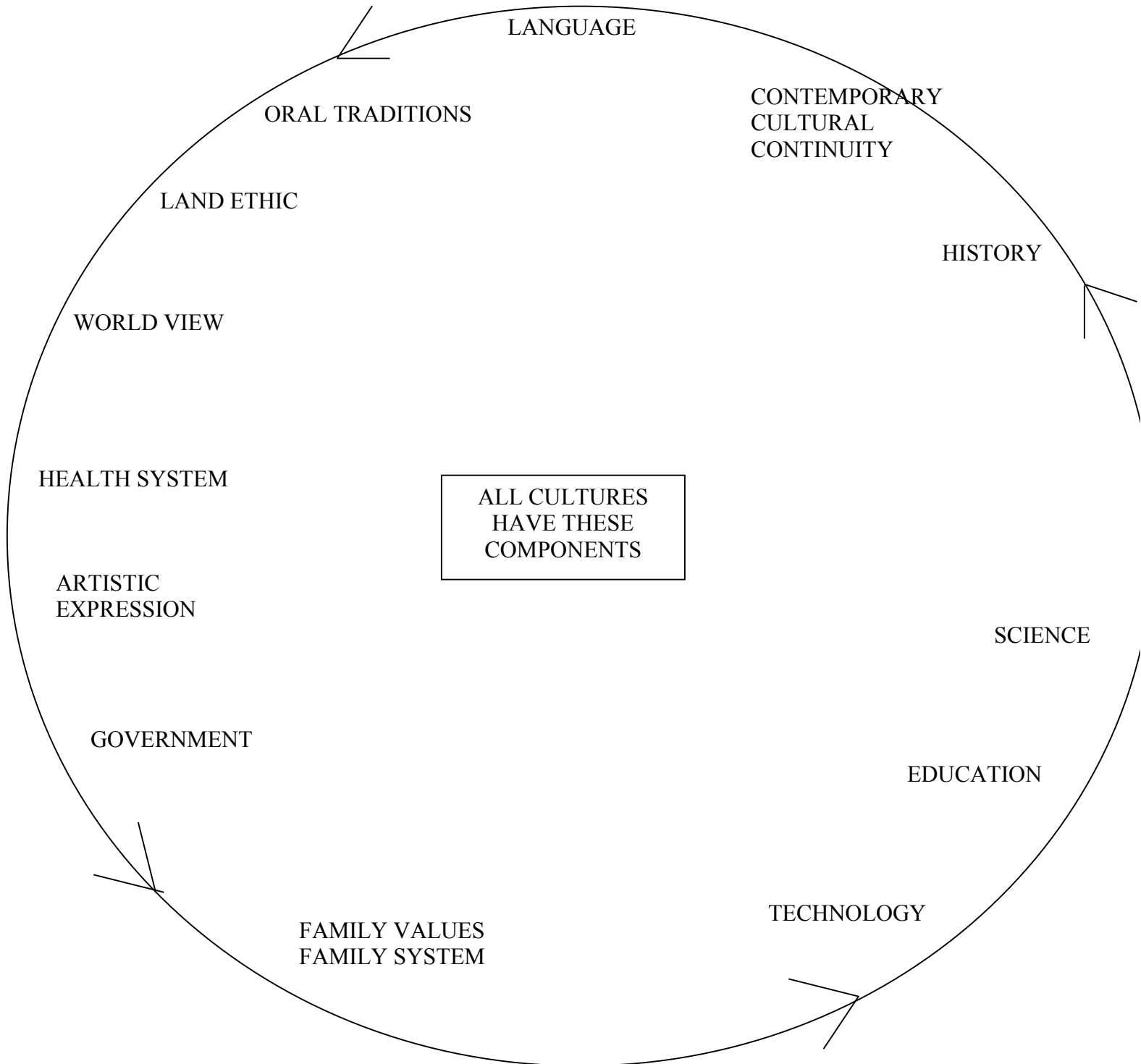


# All Cultures Chart

## CORE PRINCIPLES:

1. "The traditional ancient knowledge base of indigenous peoples continues to exist and have value within the context of the modern world." (Cornelius)
2. Self- definition by Native Peoples should be encouraged and respected. (paraphrase of Cornelius)
3. Cultural distinctiveness, uniqueness and diversity within the modern world should be accepted and celebrated. (paraphrase of Cornelius)
4. Native cultures are not static or frozen in the past, but are dynamic & selectively adoptive of new cultural components.
